ROAD CLOSURE/DETOUR PER APPROVED TMP

THE PERMITTEE MUST EMAIL THE CITY AT LEAST 24 HOURS PRIOR TO THE START OF THE JOB. WHEN BACKFILLING AND PAVING OPERATIONS ARE TO BEGIN, AS WELL AS WHEN THE JOB IS COMPLETED. THE PERMITTEE IS RESPONSIBLE FOR PERMANENT REPAIR OF THE SIDEWALK WITHIN 30 DAYS OF COMPLETION.

The Permittee and/or their contractor accept, as a condition on the permit, that the restoration charge initially assessed is an **estimated cost based on information provided by the Permittee**. The final restoration cost will be determined during permanent repair by the City and could result in additional fees to the Permittee.

The above named Permittee and/or their contractors are required to obtain, at their cost, the latest copy of the Rules and Specifications for Excavation Activity Within the City of Boston.

The above named Permittee and/or their contractors must adhere to all rules, regulations, statutes and ordinances of the City of Boston while occupying/excavating the public way.

All repairs must fully comply with ADA and AAB standards. Any repairs found to be in violation of ADA of AAB standards become the sole responsibility of the Permittee.

The Permittee is required to maintain a compliant temporary pedestrian passageway around the construction area according to ADA and AAB standards. The Permittee must maintain a safe, unobstructed vehicular traffic throughout construction.

The BPWD enforces a strict zero tolerance policy with regard to any violation(s) of the aforementioned Rules and Specifications For Excavation Activity Within the City of Boston. Cited violations MAY result in immediate shutdown and a meeting must be scheduled at City Hall before work is allowed to continue.

The BPWD will maintain a street opening rating for all Permittee's operating within the City of Boston. If the rating is found to be unacceptable or any outstanding payments to the City are not properly satisfied, **no new permits will be issued to the permittee and a citywide shutdown of all active jobs may be enforced.**

The City reserves the right to randomly order testing of any work performed within the public way, the cost of which will be sole responsibility of the Permittee.
